July 6- 10

Middle School: Aerospace & Aviation with Cradle of Aviation Museum

Aerospace & Aviation explores the science of flight and space through hands-on activities, including coding a drone, earth science dioramas, airplane activity, and a women in aeronautics panel and activity. Girls meet and learn from women in aviation and aerospace, and take part in a field trip to Aviation Center at Farmingdale State College for a behind-the-scenes tour and conversation with female aviators.

Mornings feature learning with Cradle of Aviation Museum staff; afternoons focus on team-building, confidence, and social-based activities led by Girls Inc. staff.

July 13 - 17

Middle School: Science Discovery with Brookhaven National Lab

Discovery Science is a hands-on exploration of biology, chemistry, physics, math, and astronomy through hands-on experiments. Campers explore DNA, chemical reactions, particle collisions, and how ancient astronomy connects to modern science, while learning about real-world research and technologies. The week includes a field trip to Brookhaven National Laboratory to see science in action.

Mornings feature learning with Brookhaven National Laboratory experts; afternoons focus on team-building and social-based activities led by Girls Inc. staff.

Middle School: Technology Discovery with Brookhaven National Lab

Discovery Technology introduces girls to coding, robotics, artificial intelligence, renewable energy, and engineering design through hands-on activities. Campers explore machine learning, build solar-powered cars, program robots, and take on creative engineering challenges - all while building problem-solving skills and confidence. The week also includes a special field trip to Brookhaven National Laboratory to learn about real-world STEM careers.

Mornings feature learning with Brookhaven National Laboratory experts; afternoons focus on team-building and social-based activities led by Girls Inc. staff.

High School: Week Strong – Building Your Inner Strength

This week also includes a field trip and time for connection and peer bonding.

High School: Week Smart – Expanding Your Thinking & Problem-Solving Skills

This week is all about critical thinking, exploring STEM, and making smart, informed decisions. Participants will strengthen their skills in goal-setting and problem-solving, understand the impact of their choices, and engage in hands-on STEM activities that encourage curiosity, creativity, and confidence. This week also includes a field trip and time for connection and peer bonding.

High School: Week Bold – Finding Your Voice & Leading with Confidence

This week empowers girls to discover their leadership potential and use their voice to advocate for themselves and others. Participants will build leadership skills, explore economic literacy, and gain exposure to career pathways, leaving them feeling confident, capable, and ready to make an impact. This week also includes a field trip and time for connection and peer bonding.
